## *Helping Businesses Grow Jobs*

Small businesses have been hit hard in this economy. That's why Margo supported and advocated for passage of the Economic Development Bill (HB191). The bill encourages growth by giving tax credits to businesses that expand and hire more employees.



## *Improving Our Schools*

As the state continues to lose revenue, Margo fought against cuts to our public education. As a member of the Higher Education Committee, she supported SB733, which increases some state scholarship amounts. Margo also supported HB 1543, which will improve the reporting of violent acts in schools.



## *Taking Care of the Elderly*

As Missouri's population ages, more of us are dealing with a parent or family member suffering from Alzheimer's. Margo was one of the main co-sponsors of the Alzheimer's State Plan bill. The legislation establishes a committee to develop a plan addressing the needs of Alzheimer's patients and their caregivers. Additionally, Margo sponsored HB1621, which will expand the Circuit Breaker for Seniors, providing tax relief.



## *Reducing Energy Costs*

Margo co-chaired the bi-partisan Green School Caucus and sponsored HB1667, which would establish requirements for environmentally sustainable construction for certain state-funded buildings. Sustainable buildings lower energy costs by up to 30%, saving taxpayer dollars.
